Introductory note

This note provides background information ON the Joint CNECT-RTD project meeting and workshop, supported by the EOSC secretariat¹, taking place in Brussels on 9-10 September 2019.

Context

The meeting is intended as a Concertation Meeting of EOSC-related H2020 projects² funded from the recent EOSC and related calls. It is extended to include members of the EOSC Executive and Governance Boards, which were set up in 2018³. The two DGs (DGs CONNECT and RTD) are coordinating the activities of the projects and the Boards, hence the need to bring you all together to make sure everyone is well informed about each other's activities. We also expect that over these two days many synergies and joint activities will be discovered and discussed to the benefit of all participants and the EOSC community as a whole.

For the Commission, our main objective for this meeting is to (1) identify key assets for EOSC from the projects, (2) coordinate them with the Governance objectives, (3) facilitate cooperation between the projects and the projects and the Governance structure. With the EOSC implementation in its initial stage, many questions regarding the future direction remain open, whether they relate to the future legal entity, sustainability and financing model, level of service provision, incentives for use, or link to the HPC

The format of the meeting is very open and interactive, and you will have the opportunity to participate directly in all sessions through small group discussions. You will also do the reporting by choosing rapporteurs amongst yourselves throughout the two days. Finally, we have also asked you to "sponsor" discussions and propose questions on the 3rd breakout session on "Let's talk governance".

The only boundary conditions we set is to respect the work that has been already undertaken in the field, listen to each other and come with a positive and constructive spirit to the meeting.

In the aftermath of the meeting, we will collect all input from all sessions and collate them in the final report. The report will be distributed to all participants and made public. The Commission, the EOSC Governance and Executive Boards and all other stakeholders can, without prejudice, use it to promote the objectives of EOSC and raise awareness amongst stakeholders.

Europe is at the forefront of production of scientific information in the world and we are now getting closer in becoming the major provider of the digital infrastructure, tools and services for research that will help us in overcoming the challenges of the future.

We hope that this meeting, together with all the other opportunities that will be made available to shape the future of EOSC, will help us in building EOSC that will be greater than just the sum of its parts.
