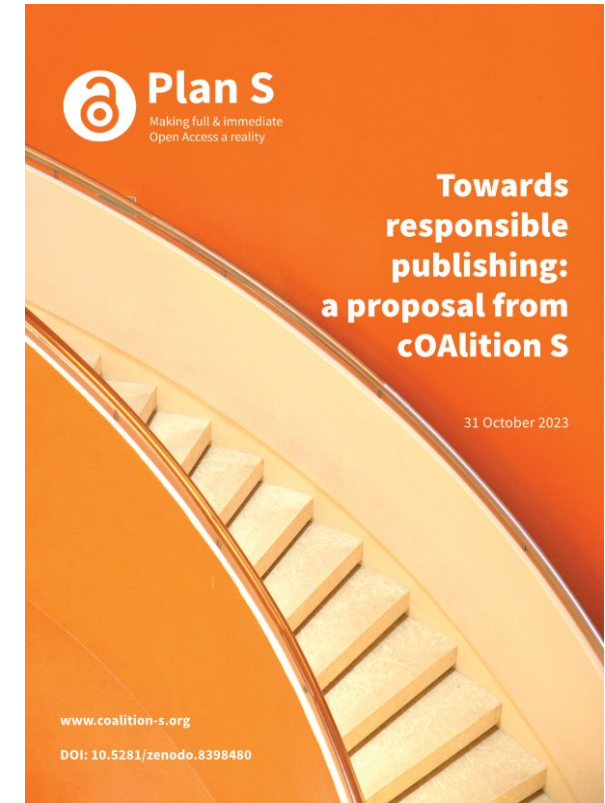

cOAlition S

- A consortium of funders who endorse the principles of **Plan S**
- **Plan S** is an initiative for Open Access publishing which requires that, from 2021, scientific publications arising from research funded by public monies, must be published in compliant Open Access journals or platforms.
- Since the principles were established and revised:
 - Technical guidance, price and service transparency frameworks, Journal Checker Tool, Rights Retention Strategy
- [Towards Responsible Publishing](#) draft proposal, 2023 – proposes a scholar-led approach.



How does SFI implement Plan S principles?

No embargo: Your peer reviewed work, supported by SFI monies, must be made available immediately.

CC-BY licence: The peer reviewed Author Accepted Manuscript (AAM) is your intellectual creation.

Rights Retention Strategy: By exercising your rights, you can share your knowledge as you wish and allow everyone to benefit from your research.

SFI grant monies cannot be used to pay for publications in **Hybrid** journals.
